New licenses must be procured on or before June 30, or a penalty will be collected pursuant to Sec. 22-338, General Statutes, State of Connecticut and an infraction incurred pursuant to Sec. 22-349.

All dogs six months or over must be licensed and wear collar and tag at all times. A dog without a tag is presumed to be unlicensed and is not protected by law. A tag must not be used on any dog other than the dog described in the license bearing corresponding number.

All dogs must be vaccinated against Rabies and owners submit a signed certificate to the Town Clerk when licensing their dog. Per C.G.S. Sec 22-338.

When a spayed or neutered dog is licensed, a certificate from a licensed veterinarian must be presented.
